These often unseen elements are what make a home perform well every day.

- **2x6 Exterior Framing:** More space for insulation and stronger structure than 2x4 framing, boosting efficiency and durability.
- **Proper Weather Barrier:** Seals out air and moisture to prevent drafts and water damage.
- **Correct Flashing:** Directs water away from windows, doors, and roof areas to avoid leaks and rot.
- **Thoughtful Insulation:** Proper placement in walls and ceilings keeps comfort consistent and lowers energy use.
- **Optimized HVAC:** Efficient equipment, smart thermostats, and duct design improve airflow and reduce utility costs.

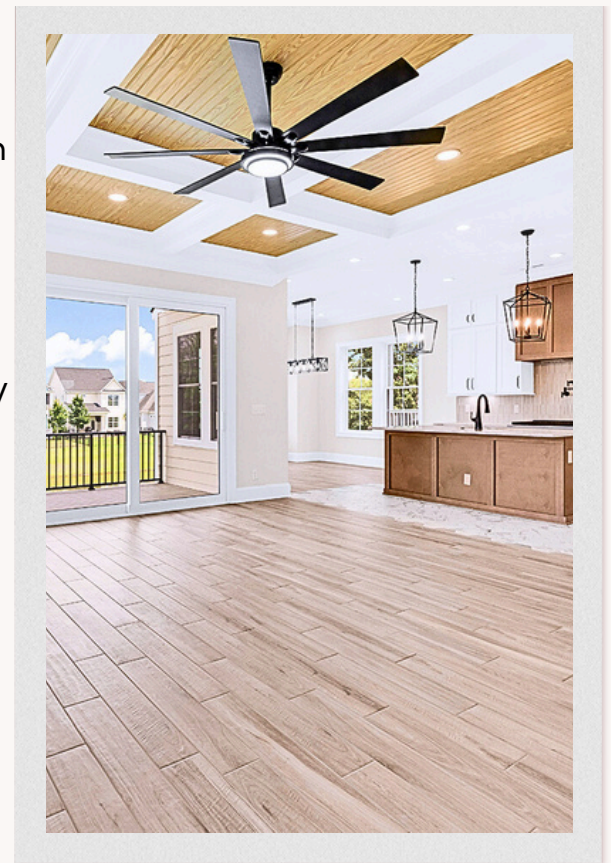
